## Position Overview

EATWISE (Educated and Aware Teens Who Inspire Smart Eating) is a youth and food program of the Food Bank for New York City. Youth work to educate and inspire smart eating among their peers. Through growing vegetables in a garden, helping to feed the hungry, organizing community action, and conducting nutrition workshops EATWISE summer interns learn to eat healthier, live better, and make change in their communities and themselves.

## Outreach Efforts

Work as a team player to:

- Plan and lead nutrition actions, workshops, and events in the community
- Gather and organize all equipment and materials for all events
- Train groups to lead their own outreach events

## Kitchen and Food Pantry

- Assist customers with pantry shopping and maintaining a clean and stocked pantry
- Operate Check-Out Counter for those customers who shopped on their own
- Assist in serving dining room consumers and maintain dining room cleanliness during service hours
- Greet guests as they enter the Community Kitchen dining room facility and make sure each person signs in on the sign-in sheet
- Prepare and serve meals

## Garden

- Plant, weed, maintain, and harvest vegetables and herbs
- Clean up site by painting boxes, creating signs, and moving planters and dirt
